

# **A Supper Of Love**

John 13:1-5 / I Cor. 11:23-32

At this “Supper of Love” our Lord washed the feet and shared a table with a traitor. Sometimes a picture of great love is seen in contrasts – when someone reaches out and loves the unloving. Even though Jesus knew the heart of Judas, even though He knew his motives, even though He knew his plans, He still loved Judas. He offered him several opportunities to repent before it was too late but Judas was a traitor.

Judas no doubt had a heart of irreverence. We can fall into the danger of acting like Judas! We are to examine our lives – then partake with gratitude!

The Lord’s Supper is a supper of love. So...what does it mean to be worthy (“*unworthily*” – *V.27*) and to enjoy “The Lord’s Supper?” What are ways that we love Jesus back... for loving us?

## **I. Love Him Back... By Being Saved**

- A. His Sacrifice... Cost Him His Life
- B. His Salvation... Cost Us Nothing

## **II. Love Him Back... By Being Baptized**

- A. Baptism = is after salvation
- B. Baptism = is by burial in water.
- C. Baptism = is required for church membership

## **III. Love Him Back... By Being In Fellowship With Jesus Christ**

- A. Examine
- B. Ask
- C. Confess

## **IV. Love Him Back... By Being In Fellowship With Others**

- A. Forgive Offenses
- B. Forget Revenge

## **V. Love Him Back... By Being Obedient to God’s Will**

- A. Agree To Follow His will.
- B. Obey His Will – as He shows you.
