

“His Timing Proves His Love”

(The Proving Of God’s Love Part 2)

Ecclesiastes 3:10-15 – V.11 = “...in His time.”

God controls everything in the universe. He is the Controller of the Seasons, and the Controller of exact timing for every reason or purpose under Him! God’s perfect timing expresses His great love for mankind.

Let’s think about how much God loves us – and proves it by His timing... “The Love of God’s Timing...”

I. It’s Been Perfect In The Past.

A. He’s Intervened... In Certain Death: Gen. 22.

B. He’s Intervened... In Certain Danger: Luke 8:22-25.

C. He’s Intervened... In Certain Deliverance: Gal. 4:4-5 = the Birth of Jesus – “But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.”

II. It’s Perfect In The Present: *In the “Right Now.” He shows us His love by...*

A. **Stepping In** – when we are overwhelmed by troubles: Ps. 46:1 “God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.” - Just at the right moment... God steps in and proves His love!

B. **Supplying An Escape** – I Cor. 10:13 “There hath no temptation (GK: **pi-ras-mos'** *testing, solicitation to sin or adversity*) taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer (*allow*) you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation (GK: **pi-ras-mos'** *testing, solicitation to sin or adversity*) also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.”

C. **Showing Patience For The Lost** – V. 17 = II Cor. 6:2 “... behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.”

III. It Will Be Perfect In The Future – two major events in time that will prove His Love...

A. The Time: When Jesus Will Come For The Church

1. It will be an exact moment = I Cor. 15:51-52 “Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”

2. It is a hidden moment = like a thief in the night = I Thess. 5:1-2 “But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.”

B. The Time: When Jesus Will Come To Reign Over Israel –

1. It will be preceded by signs; and will be open for the world to see = but it too is a hidden moment. Matt. 24:36 “But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.”
