We also had the problem of a meeting place. The hotel where we were meeting before, is now a quarantine site and closed to the public. It seemed that there were no options available to us, then the Lord opened the door for us to use the George Arts Theatre. It has worked out well for us and is in some ways, a better venue than the hotel.



As in many places, the lockdown has had a very bad impact upon the economy, and many people are struggling to meet their basic living cost.



Through the Agape Baptist Church and fundraising efforts of the Inspire George non-profit, many people have been helped with food parcels and other basic needs. We appreciate your prayers for our people as they struggle through this time. Many small businesses will not recover. Pray for God's intervention and the spiritual grow of our churches.

In the last few weeks, we have started meeting with a group of Malawian men. There is a language barrier, so pray for them that they will be able to understand and grow in the Word. Pray for us to be able to communicate effectively.
