During a missions conference in Florida last year, I asked the children in one of our evening programs, “Who knows what a missionary is?” One of the little boys sitting in the front shot his hand up in the air. When I called on him, he replied, “A missionary is a homeless person.” How true this statement is on an earthly level.

Our Canadian visas expired the first week of July. Because the border is still closed to back-and-forth traffic, we were unable to renew our visas to stay in Québec for the month of July. Instead, we homeless missionaries have moved five times this past month while Becca and I continued our daily online classes. We moved from the language school in Québec to a camp in PA, to a missionary house in GA, to family’s house in GA, back to the missionary house in GA, and finally to the missionary house we are staying in now as I type this message in Chattanooga, TN. Please pray for the U.S./Canadian border to reopen this month, and pray that we can get new visas for our third and final semester of French language studies (September 1-mid December). As you can imagine, it is much more difficult to learn a language when you are not immersed in that language and culture every day.

Because our entire family of six is enrolled for next semester, the language school has given us a considerable discount on tuition. As a result of the generosity of so many of you, our supporters, more than half of our third semester of tuition has already come in! We have been tremendously encouraged by this outpouring of generosity, support, and love. Please pray for God’s provision of the remaining approximately \$5,000 we will need over the next five months to pay for our third and final semester in Québec.

Pastor Burns and the church in Québec have been such a huge blessing to us these past six months. The Burns family and many members of the Église Baptiste du Berger (Shepherd Baptist Church) have become dear friends. The church also gave a very generous offering toward our tuition fund. Pastor Burns has invited us to become more active in some of the ministries of the church next semester. Please pray that our French competency will improve to the level that we will be able to teach, preach, and get more involved in discipleship this final semester.

The conflicts in the Northwest and Southwest Regions of Cameroon continue. Please pray for our dear Cameroonian friends suffering and struggling each day. Pray for peace in Cameroon. Pray for a national and global revival. Pray for the furtherance of the Gospel to the glory of God in these last days.
