Our mission in Perú continues to seek ways to grow through the teaching of God’s Word. Covid restrictions are slowly lifting. We’re currently allowed to meet up to 40% of our capacity. This continues to be a problem as we don’t have much space and have been praying that God would allow us to purchase property and build a suitable church building. We have started a building fund (with our sending church) and are looking for God to meet our need. Small lots are available in our area for \$20,000 each, and we would like to purchase five adjoining lots for the church. Our church has been focusing on food bags, medicine, and medical emergencies throughout Covid for those in drastic need. We are meeting in person as a church every Sunday and Wednesday.



The children in our area still are not able to meet in person for school and are playing in the streets throughout the day as their parents return to work. We are providing a VBS in July and are praying for God to use it to help the children grow in their relationship with God.

Please continue to pray for Perú, as Covid is still affecting livelihoods. They are currently vaccinating those 50 years and above. The presidential elections are still ongoing, with the final two candidates still so close that they are doing investigations before announcing a final decision. The new president is to be sworn in on Independence Day, July 28th.

Family Update: We are excited to announce that all four of our children have decided to attend Maranatha Baptist University this fall. They are stepping out in faith that God would provide for them to finish the year financially. They each have been working this summer and will be receiving scholarships, along with grant money, but will still be short of funds for the second semester. We are thankful to God for granting us good health and traveling mercies this last month. We were encouraged with visitors from Trujillo, Perú to assist us in the ministry for a week in July.

Thank you for partnering with us as we serve God in the high jungle of Chontabamba, Perú.
