Greetings from our home base near Chattanooga, Tennessee. Thank you for praying for Becca and Kate to recover from their malaria. Because of her fall and probable concussion, Becca suffered from vertigo for several weeks. Thankfully, everyone has fully recovered and is doing well now.

Since returning to the States, we have had the privilege of visiting family, starting some needed dental work, and personally updating nine churches in about a month. In between meetings, we have been busy getting the kids ready for college by opening bank accounts, getting learner's permits (for all the girls), buying cell phones, and filling out lots of college paperwork. Please pray for us as we continue our furlough update ministry.

We had family pictures taken this week, and as soon as we get those back, we will produce new prayer cards and send them out to our supporters. Other highlights from the past month include meeting Usman in a Walmart in East Tennessee. He arrived from Mali, West Africa, about ten weeks ago. We had the opportunity to converse with him entirely in French and share the Gospel. One new church we visited voted to begin supporting us monthly. In one service, two families came forward during an invitation to surrender their lives to missions. I met a senior in high school after one service who believes God is calling him to reach Muslims in Africa. Finally, yesterday we received a message from a couple in Texas who believe God may be calling them to Cameroon. We are excited about following up with them to explore how God can use them to further the Gospel in Cameroon for the glory of God.

During our last service with Bible Light Baptist Church in Kribi, I had the privilege of preaching the message in English and reading my own translation in French. We had three first-time visitors and four baptized. I have been in touch with Pastor Eugene each week since our departure. He recently informed me of a man who started attending a couple of months ago. Josué has not only trusted in Christ for salvation, but he believes God has called him into ministry and desires to formally train in order to serve the Lord. Praise God!

We are thrilled to be in the service of the Lord. We are thankful for our faithful partners and rejoice in the daily opportunities to minister for our Lord. Please pray for us as we continue to travel from state to state, updating churches and making the difficult transition of dropping half of our children off at college this month. We appreciate our prayer partners and supporters more than we can express. God bless you.
